## Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP)

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#### Introduction

The Palouse Regional Transportation Planning Organization (Palouse RTPO) is made up of a four-county area (Asotin, Columbia, Garfield, and Whitman Counties) and members include counties, cities, tribal nations, transit agencies, and ports. The Palouse Regional Transportation Improvement Program (RTIP) is a compilation of transportation projects located within the Palouse RTPO and proposed for implementation during a six-year period. This RTIP is for projects scheduled during the years 2025-2030.

The Palouse RTIP includes projects that are federally funded and considered to be regionally significant, as defined within the long-range Palouse Regional Transportation Plan. The RTIP describes the projects, provides projected costs, and the schedule for completion and associated funding sources. The RTIP is consistent with the adopted long-range Palouse Regional Transportation Plan, which can be found under Plans & Studies at <a href="https://www.palousertpo.org">www.palousertpo.org</a>.

Palouse RTPO member agencies who are administering projects that are located within the Lewis-Clark Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization (LCVMPO) submit their projects to the MPO (this includes Asotin County, City of Clarkston, and City of Asotin). Projects located within these agencies but outside of the MPO boundary would be included in the Palouse RTPO RTIP. Included as Appendix A are copies of Palouse RTPO local agency Transportation Improvement Plans which may include not only regionally significant and federally funded projects, but all other locally planned projects that are funded with other sources or are only planned at this time and awaiting secured funding.

#### Development of the RTIP

Washington State regulations, specifically RCW 47.80.023 require the development of a six-year RTIP that must be updated at least every two years. Each updated RTIP is formed using local Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs) developed by Palouse RTPO member agencies. The State of Washington requires cities, towns, counties, and tribes to annually prepare a TIP with a list of proposed transportation projects. The RTIP is to include regionally significant transportation projects, programs, and transportation demand management measures. Regionally significant project means a transportation project that is on a facility that serves regional transportation needs (such as access to and from the area outside the region; major activity centers in the region; major planned developments such as new retail malls, sports complexes, or employment centers; or transportation terminals). At a minimum, this includes all principal arterial highways and all fixed guideway transit facilities that offer an alternative to regional highway travel.

The development of the RTIP begins in August of each year when local jurisdictions and agencies provide copies of their local TIPs to the Palouse RTPO. The local TIPs are then compiled into a comprehensive document. The Palouse RTPO is responsible for checking the consistency of submitted TIP projects with the Palouse Regional Transportation Plan. The RTIP is presented to the Washington State Department of Transportation (WSDOT) following Palouse RTPO Policy Board approval for inclusion in the Statewide Transportation Improvement Plan (STIP). Only projects with secure funding are included in the STIP. Projects with planned funds

are left in the RTIP until they are ready to move from planned to secured funding. In the project descriptions, a letter "P" indicates planned funding, and a letter "S" indicates secured funding. Once projects with planned funds are secured, the RTPO forwards the projects to WSDOT for inclusion in the STIP. The STIP has a public review period similar to the RTIP. #### **Policy for Amendments**

The Palouse RTIP is generally adopted in September of each year; however, counties can submit their projects until December when they adopt their six-year plan. Projects can also be added, removed, or modified between January and October of the following calendar year through amending the RTIP. The Palouse RTPO uses the same process to update the RTIP that WSDOT uses to update the STIP, following the annual schedule for project amendment deadlines. New projects, or those requiring amendment beyond the WSDOT administrative thresholds are brought before the TAC for discussion and recommendation to the Policy Board for approval. Palouse RTPO TAC and Policy Board meetings are open meetings where the public is welcome and encouraged to attend and participate. The Palouse RTPO will update the RTIP once amendments are approved by the Policy Board.

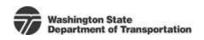

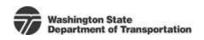
